None of our leaders or committee members are paid, they are all volunteers

The majority of our leaders and committee members have a full time job and a family

At last year's World Scout Jamboree held in the UK 30,000 participants were supported by 10,000 adults.

Not all volunteers are required to wear uniform

Adults get involved because they want to have fun and make new friends

Volunteering does not have to be helping run a section every week.

We can tailor a role around the time and skills you have to offer.

We all have hobbies and skills. Maybe you could run an evening on music, origami, IT, motor mechanics or woodwork

We are always looking for adults to work with young people.

We also need help with accounts, building maintenance, PR and fund raising.

The one thing that unites our leaders is the energy and enthusiasm they have for giving young people the adventure of Scouting
